Specifications (suggested reading in conjunction with the plans):

This Villa is 500sqm in size

This 4 tiered villa is situated on the par 5, 16th hole and has breathtaking views over the Indian Ocean and Pinnacle Point Clubhouse. On the top level, the villa has 4 bedrooms with full en-suite bathrooms. All these bedrooms have their own balcony to admire the breathtaking view. The 5th bedroom is on the northern side of the house and on the ground floor. Bedroom 1, 2 and 5 have queen beds where bedrooms 3 and 4 have two single beds each.

On the third tier there is an automated double car and a single golf cart garage. The entrance and front door is situated on the second tier where you will find the guest toilet and TV Lounge. The Lounge consists of a Plasma TV with Satellite and a DVD player with surround sound. Lastly on the bottom tier there are a fully equipped kitchen, dining room and entertainment area. Both the dining room and the entertainment room, with pool table, have folding stack doors that open up onto the undercover patio with outside dining furniture, wooden sundeck and a built-in braai. At the sundeck you will find a rim-flow swimming pool watching golfers and the Pinnacle.

The villa sleeps 10 People and is self catering. You also have your own golf cart at your disposal.

Check-in and Check-out

The check in time is at 2pm on your date of arrival and 10am on your date of departure.

Upon your arrival at Pinnacle Point you need to report to the Pinnacle Point Reception Office. Your ID needs to be presented to them. Please ask them for the directions to your villa, as it can be quite tricky. You need to inform Jarkie Property Management of your arrival, please supply them with full names of all guests, car registration number and rental car information prior to your arrival. The keys to the villa will be at the front door of the villa in a key safe whereby you will be provided with that pin upon your arrival. Upon departure, visitor's should return the keys to the key safe.

Home attendant's working hours is from Monday - Friday 9am to 4pm and Saturday 9am – 12:30pm.

Rules and Regulations

- Smoking inside the villa and in the golf cart is not allowed.
- Speed limits within the Resort should be adhered to at all times.
- Only discreet music is allowed until 10pm. No music will be allowed thereafter. The same applies to voices. Voices travel far and it is expected to keep noise levels to a minimum.
- Home attendants may not wash personal clothes. Washing machine and tumble dryer are at your disposal.
- No pets are allowed on the Estate.
- A R350 fee applies on late check-out.
- A fee will be charged if the keys have not been returned to the key safe upon your departure or have been lost.
- The swimming pool has a safety net. Once the safety net has been taken off the swimming pool it is the visitor's responsibility to manage the safety of children and all parties staying in the property. The owner, shareholders, managing agent, service provider, exchange and rental agent can not be held responsible for the safety of visitors. The pool net must be put back on the pool when not in use as the estate security also issues fines of R1500 for this if found off.
- Only persons with a valid drivers licence may operate the golf cart.
- A maximum of 4 people on the golf cart.
- After each and every usage of the golf cart the golf cart should be plugged into the charger. This is important for the usage of the golf cart batteries.
- The Estate Rules must please be read and adhered to at all times as there are major fines issued for breaking of the estate rules eg: Cutting of fynbos and littering in the estate.
- Guests are NOT allowed to destroy fynbos in any manner – eg: walking on it (an owner was issued with a R5000 fine for cutting fynbos for display in her home) We are not even allowed to cut fynbos where it is obscuring the view of the golf course.
- This is a privately owned villa and the owners requested you to thoroughly enjoy all the benefits that this villa has to offer, but also to treat the villa with the necessary respect as if it was your own.
